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The Nisonger Center Early Childhood Education Program and the OSU Child Care Program have a collaboration to provide a nurturing environment where children receive consultation therapies and Early Intervention Services within their typical day at child care.

Therapists work with the children inside their classroom setting as a inclusive model. Therapists also consult with teachers and parents to develop strategies for improving development across all settings.

Services available include:

- Early Intervention
- Speech Therapy
- Occupational Therapy
- Physical Therapy



To enroll in the program, children must first be determined eligible through Help Me Grow of Franklin County. Part-time and full-time childcare enrollments are available. Families do not need to be affiliated with OSU to be enrolled in this program. A discount on child care is offered to children enrolled in the Early Intervention Program. Funded child care is also available to those who qualify.

If you feel your child is at risk for a delay, we are able to observe him/her in their classroom and make informed recommendations based on the observation. We are able to assist with becoming involved with Help Me Grow who will conduct a more lengthy battery of assessments and ultimately determine if your child qualifies to receive services from the Early Intervention Program.
