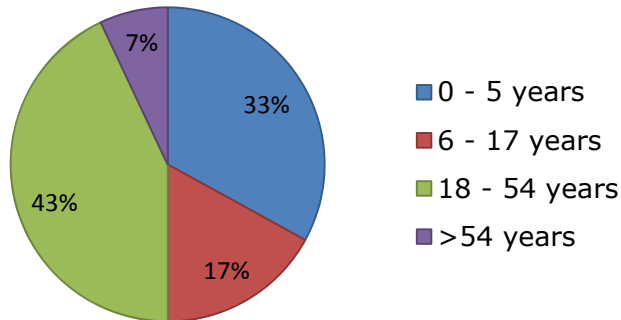


BY-THE-NUMBERS (2015-2016)

7,795 individuals with developmental disabilities and their families received services and assistance.
