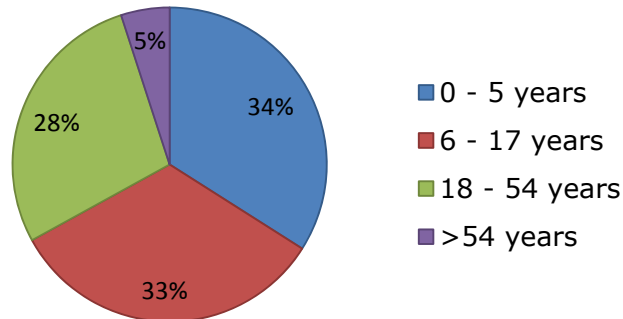


BY-THE-NUMBERS (2016-2017)
