

Do you have a child on the Autism Spectrum?



Is your child taking Risperdal, Abilify, or similar medicine for behavior issues?

Has your child gained too much weight?

If so, you may want to consider participating in a study of metformin (Riomet), a medicine sometimes used to help patients with diabetes by decreasing the amount of sugar absorbed into the body.

Researchers at Nationwide Children's Hospital and Ohio State University's Nisonger Center are trying to determine if Riomet can help children with Autism Spectrum Disorders lose weight they have gained from these types of medicines.
