PURPOSE	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• To provide dental health services for adults with intellectual and developmental disabilities (IDD) ages 18 and up.• To provide training for students enrolled in dental and dental hygiene programs as well as general practice residents and fellows.• To provide technical assistance to community agencies and programs that will improve and enhance oral health.
PERSONS SERVED	People with developmental disabilities throughout Ohio are eligible to receive services.
STAFF	The Nisonger Dental Program has a professional staff composed of a general dentist, dental hygienist, dental assistants, an office manager, residents, fellows, and dental & dental hygiene students.
SERVICES	A complete range of oral health services is available. When appropriate, referrals to dental specialists will be made.
TIME	The McCampbell Hall facility is open Monday through Friday with services available by appointment.
COST	A variety of insurance plans are accepted; to include Medicaid, CareSource, and Molina. For our underinsured/uninsured patients we offer a sliding fee scale based on family size and income. Payment arrangements are available.

- PURPOSE**
- To provide oral health services for infants and children through age 17 with and without developmental disabilities.
 - To provide training for students enrolled in dental and dental hygiene programs as well as pediatric dental residents and fellows.
 - To provide technical assistance to community agencies and programs that will improve and enhance oral health.

- PERSONS SERVED**
- Children enrolled in the Franklin County Early Childhood Education Center partner programs, including FCBDD, YMCA, CDC Head Start, and Columbus K and pre-K.
 - Children in Franklin County ages 0-17 who are underserved and have not established a “dental home.”

STAFF The Nisonger Dental Program: Johnstown Road has a professional staff composed of a pediatric dentist, dental assistants with advanced training (EFDA), pediatric dental residents & fellows, and dental & dental hygiene students.

SERVICES A complete range of oral health services is available. Referral to dental specialists will be made when needed.

TIME The Nisonger Dental Program: Johnstown Road is open Monday through Friday with services available by appointment.

COST A variety of insurance plans are accepted; to include Medicaid, CareSource, and Molina. For our underinsured/uninsured patients we offer a sliding fee scale based on family size and income. Payment arrangements are available.
