Susan M. Havercamp, PhD. is Professor of Psychiatry and Behavioral Health at the Ohio State University Nisonger Center. Her research focuses on improving the physical and mental health of people with disabilities. Dr. Havercamp is the Principal Investigator of the Rehabilitation Research and Training Center to understand and improve mental health of people with intellectual disability funded by the National Institute on Disability, Independent Living, and Rehabilitation Research. As the director of the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention-funded Ohio Disability and Health Program, she has conducted health disparity research, designed and evaluated health promotion programs for people with disabilities, and developed disability training programs for interdisciplinary healthcare professionals. She strongly believes that education is the solution to many health inequities people with disabilities face. Dr. Havercamp is past president of the American Association on Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities and the Alliance on Disability in Health Care Education.
