Who can Participate?

In order to be part of this program, you must:

- ✓ Have a disability (includes learning disabilities, etc)
- ✓ be 18+ years old
- ✓ Live in Central Ohio*
*Counties: Franklin, Delaware, Fairfield, Pickaway, Madison, Licking, Union

Why did we create the linkage program?

Adults with disabilities sometimes have worse mental health, physical health, and chronic condition outcomes compared to adults without disabilities.

The most common problems are:

- bad healthcare provider understanding about disability,
- being denied appointments,
- physical inaccessibility of buildings and places,
- inaccessibility of equipment like exam tables,
- inadequate insurance coverage
- lack of transportation.

Our job is to make these problems go away so you can just focus on your health!
